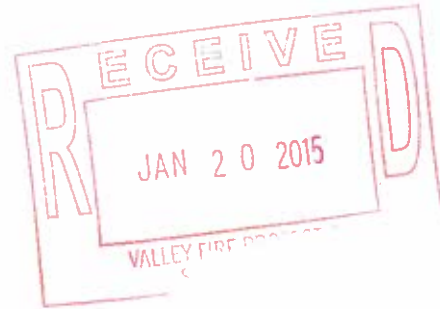

We hope you will encourage others to join the American Backflow Prevention Association, as membership in the ABPA would be very beneficial.

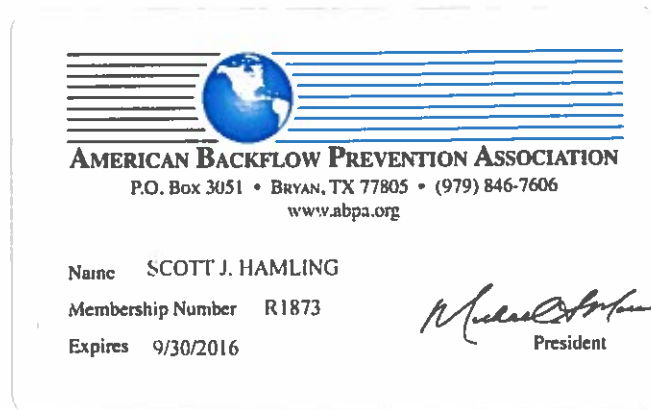
Please be assured that your support of the American Backflow Prevention Association, through your participation and membership, is greatly appreciated. Please note that your dues and contributions are tax-deductible.
